Introducing Regulation of Light Fixture Insulation

ELECTRICAL SHOCK PROTECTION

Each luminaire is insulated so that any exposed metal parts do not carry electrical current.

Parts that carry current during normal operation must be protected against contact either by insulation or a suitable cover. Additional measures are taken to prevent exposed metal parts carrying current even if an insulation fault occurs.

IGNITION/FIRE PROTECTION

When operated, luminaires generate heat. The following symbols are used for luminaires that can be mounted on flammable materials.
